If you ever want to make an impact in the life of a child, **this is the program.**

*- CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate) Volunteer*

**91 CASA volunteers** spoke out for children in the local court systems.

**200 children and 99 families** were served by SCAN's CASA Program.

**9,400 CASA volunteer hours** had a combined value of \$176,350.

I can summarize my impressions in one sentence: **They brought me hope.**

**123 parents and 103 children** were educated through parent support groups.

**124 adults and 204 children** attended Success by 6<sup>®</sup> playgroups.

**190 parents and 203 children** were reached through SCAN's parenting classes.
