- **Corporate groups**, like the Boeing Employee Community Fund, to present to Boeing Employees about SCAN
- **Schools**, like FB Meekins Cooperative Preschool where we discussed how to prevent child sexual abuse with parents and caregivers
- **Child welfare events**, like the State Child Abuse Prevention Conference where we recently presented on "Engaging Diverse Communities" with a group of 40 attendees
- **Nonprofit organizations**, like UMFS, where we spoke at a staff meeting about the ways in which SCAN can be a community partner
