Family member demonstrates that they know how to set up the crib and lock.		
It is understood that baby is NOT to be placed on sofas, recliners, waterbeds, bean bags, air mattresses, soft mattresses for sleeping.		
Knows how to place infant in crib (on their back) and the Safe Sleep education pamphlets explanation of why a higher incidence of sleep-related death occurs when infant is placed on their stomach.		
No pillows, soft toys, blankets, crib bumpers, or stuffed animals are to be placed in the crib. Do not overheat baby.		
Use only a firm mattress with a fitted sheet.		
Reviewed the hazards of bed sharing. Adult beds can be dangerous because of roll off, trapped, blankets, adult/child can roll over infant.		
Explain sleep-related deaths – leading cause of death among infants under 6 months, during the winter months, in premature infants, and in African-American infants.		
No one will smoke around the infant or in the infant's environment.		
Make sure to notify all family and caregivers that you leave the baby with to follow the same rules.		
Reviewed traumatic brain injury facts and how to soothe a crying baby.		
Completed the "My Baby's Crying Plan" magnet with parent.		
Signed the "Safe Sleep" pledge		
Signed the "Hold Harmless" agreement and is attached.
